

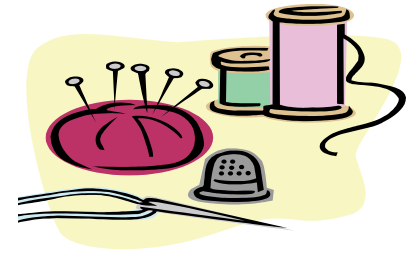
QUILTING BASICS 10 MONTHS OF LEARNING

Starting in January, quilting basics will begin. The program consists of 10 classes beginning with basic rotary cutting and ending with machine quilting and binding. You may sign up for all, or just the class that covers the techniques you need help on.

The first class will be an introductory to quilting class. We will cover quilting terms, how to choose fabric, and rotary cutting basics. We will also work on setting your quarter inch seam and pressing hints.

Supplies needed for the first class are: Notebook

Rotary cutter, mat and rulers

Sewing machine in working order

Thread
